The NYC St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee  
is accepting Volunteers.

## Role for Volunteers

Organize the groups participating in the parade, assist along the Parade route, and keeping the Marchers spaced out and flowing properly.

## Where

The parade route goes up Fifth Avenue beginning at 44<sup>th</sup> Street and ending at 79<sup>th</sup> Street  
(The grandstands at 64<sup>th</sup> Street and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue)

## When

Saturday, March 16<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers needed 9am – 5pm (parade runs 11am till approx. 4:30pm)

## Why

Approximately 150,000 people march in the parade which draws about 2 million spectators.

## Who

Responsible individuals 18 years old+

## Dress Code

Business casual attire is required. Parade regulations stipulate NO beads, green hats, green sneakers, other eccentric apparel or displays of any kind.
